SUBJECT: Youth Sports Standardization

BACKGROUND

Staff is developing and launching a project to standardize the registration process for Minneapolis Park and Recreation Board (MPRB) youth sports participation. Staff will discuss project's purpose, timeline and intended outcomes.

The MPRB provides youth sports programs to thousands of young people across the system each year. It is the goal of the MPRB to ensure that every participant has a high quality and consistent experience at each of our facilities.

Standardizing the fees and processes associated with playing youth sports with MPRB is a part of our commitment to providing excellent customer service. Additionally, standardizing the process will also increase family's ability to identify available teams and thereby reduce the number of children that "sit the season out" due to the inability to play on their neighborhood park's team.

Lastly, standardizing the youth sports fees and participation processes will help to lessen confusion that community members may experience with our existing range of fees and it will help distinguish MPRB provided programs from other organizations which may be using our facilities.
